April 1, 2023, Medicare beneficiaries with a Medicare Advantage plan may pay lower coinsurance for some Part B drugs if the drug's price increased faster than the rate of inflation in a quarter.	Possible lower costs
Chapter 6 - Page 106	Missing	Explains the changes made by the Inflation Reduction Act. Since you pay \$0 for insulin this would not apply to you.	Possible lower costs.
