**Information Regarding Inflation Reduction Act**

**Coinsurance for Part B Drugs**

You currently pay 20% coinsurance for Part B drugs. Beginning April 1, 2023, Medicare beneficiaries with a Medicare Advantage plan may pay lower coinsurance for some Part B drugs if the drug's price increased faster than the rate of inflation in a quarter.
